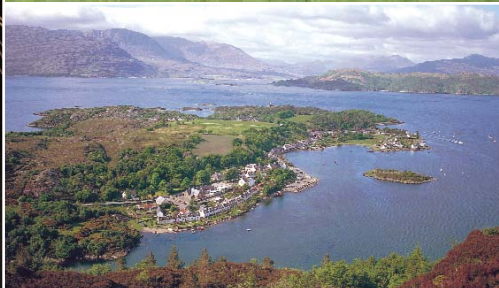

Ym 1999 clustnodwyd £220 miliwn i greu llefydd gofal plant tu allan i oriau ysgol newydd a chynaliadwy ar gyfer 865,000 o blant ar draws y DU erbyn 2003. Yn 2002 clustnodwyd £198.5 miliwn pellach i estyn y rhaglen gynharach ac i ariannu prosiectau adeiladu cyfalaf. Mae'r rhaglenni dan y fenter hon yn cynnwys.

Dros gyfnod y rhaglenni hyn mae'r Gronfa wedi cynnig grantiau gwerth cyfanswm o £390.6 miliwn sef 98% o'r cyfanswm oedd ar gael. Rhwng 1 Ebrill 2004 a 31 Mawrth 2005 cynigiwyd 267 o grantiau gyda chyfanswm o £21.8 miliwn o dan y rhaglenni gofal plant.

Dysgu tu allan i oriau ysgol

Clustnodwyd £205 miliwn, gan gynnwys £25 miliwn i ysgolion haf, ar gyfer darparu gweithgareddau dysgu tu allan i oriau ysgol i hanner yr holl ysgolion uwchradd ac ysgolion arbennig a chwarter yr holl ysgolion cynradd. Estynnwyd y cynllun yn ddiweddarach gyda £25.5 miliwn ar gael i ariannu cydlynwyr chwaraeon ysgol. Yn ystod 2004/05 dyrannwyd £28.4 miliwn pellach yn Lloegr i estyn ariannu cydlynwyr chwaraeon ysgol fel rhan o'r Gronfa Pobl Ifanc.

Dros gyfnod y fenter mae'r Gronfa wedi cynnig grantiau gwerth £215.3 miliwn sef 89% o'r arian sydd ar gael dan y fenter hon.

Rhwng 1 Ebrill 2004 a 31 Mawrth 2005 cynigiwyd 13 grant gwerth £0.2 miliwn o dan y fenter dysgu tu allan i oriau ysgol, a chynigiwyd 103 grant gwerth £8.6 miliwn o dan y rhaglen cydlynwyr chwaraeon ysgol.
